

TOEFL iBT® Home Edition

Before registering for the TOEFL iBT Home Edition, be sure that your computer and testing area meet the following requirements:



EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Desktop or laptop:** You can only use one screen and a mobile device if a second camera set up applies to you (see your Order Confirmation email for details).
- Operating System: PC:** Windows®10 or higher **MAC®:** Mac OS X® 10.13 or higher
- Download, install and run the **TOEFL Test App** first.
- Run the **TOEFL Test App** Equipment Check.
- Must use an **internal** or **external speaker**. Headsets are not allowed.
- Must use an **internal** or **external microphone** that is not part of a headset.
- Use a **built-in camera** or a **separate webcam**.
- Must be able to move around the room in order to show a **360-degree view of the room**, including your tabletop surface and the area below it

Second Camera Requirements:

- Smartphone or tablet
- With a working camera
- That runs iOS 12+ or Android 8+
- Has a stable internet connection
- Power adaptor/charge cord
- Stable, heavy object to support your device

ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

- You must be **alone** in a room with doors closed. **No one** may enter the room. Testing in a public space is not allowed.
- Cover all** transparent walls, doors or large open windows.
- Clear the walls** of any material related to the test.
- Computer and keyboard must be on a **desk or tabletop surface** and remain connected to a power supply.
- Seat must be a **standard chair** — not a couch, bed or overstuffed chair.
- Position your table and chair so **the door to the room will be visible** to the proctor.
- Tabletop and surrounding area must be **clear of all unapproved items**. Food and drink are not allowed during the test.
- Dress appropriately:** you will be monitored via camera by a proctor. A photo will be taken for score reports that are shared with institutions.
- For security, **remove all accessories, jewelry, hairbands and hats**. You may wear a religious head covering, but **ears** must be always visible.
- You may **not** take notes on regular paper, for security reasons. **For note-taking, you should use:**
 - a small whiteboard and erasable pen *or*
 - blank paper in transparent sheet protector and erasable pen

Preventing Issues

- **Turn off other devices that are using significant internet bandwidth** because they can cause issues during your test.
- **Close all browsers and applications** that you don't need for the test.
- **Disable screen-sharing and remote-access software.** Keep them disabled and set so that they won't open automatically during the test.

1

Check if you fulfill the Equipment and Environment Requirements

Confirm your computer and testing area **meet the requirements** before registering for the TOEFL iBT Home Edition. You will only be allowed to test if you are able to fulfill all the requirements.

2

Register for a test

Register through the [TOEFL website](#) (if eligible for disability accommodations, apply for these FIRST to get approval before booking a test). Select the option “Online.” Book your test and pay for it.

3

Prepare for the test
